Background

The recent external evaluation of Borders Voluntary Care Voice (BVCV), commissioned by BVCV, recommended that BVCV needs to improve how it is marketed.

This Resolution concerns one specific issue identified by the Board.

The Board are of the opinion that the word “Voluntary” has caused some stakeholders to misunderstand the role of BVCV. Specifically, some stakeholders believe that BVCV only represents volunteers in the care sector. That of course is not the case.

The process for changing the name of BVCV

Three steps:

1. OSCR gives consent to the proposed new name.
2. BVCV amends its constitution to specify the new name.
3. BVCV notifies OSCR that its constitution has been amended (to allow OSCR to amend the register).

The Board asked OSCR for its consent to change its name to “Borders Care Voice”. OSCR gave its consent to this change on 13th June 2017.

Resolution proposed by the Board of BVCV

That clause 3 of the constitution be amended with immediate effect to read:

The name of the organisation is Borders Care Voice which may be abbreviated to BCV.
