- ❖ Clearly describe their duty of co-operation during an Adult Support and Protection inquiry/investigation process.
- ❖ Recognise when to seek appropriate professional advice and guidance in relation to Adult Support and Protection and where to find this
- ❖ Demonstrate awareness of Scottish Borders multi-agency Adult Support and Protection procedures and the role of the Adult Protection Unit/Adult Protection Committee
- ❖ Know how to make an Adult Support and Protection referral to Scottish Borders Council social work department
- ❖ Understand the Adult Support and Protection process via experience of case study
