****Day 2** should only be attended by staff with legal responsibility for managing and conducting Adult Support and Protection investigations: SBC Team Leaders /Assistant Team Leaders / Integrated Team Managers and SBC staff eligible to become accredited Adult Support and Protection Council Officers.
